

NBHA Canada Fall Frenzy 2020 Covid Protocols

To comply with our regions restrictions, the NBHA has formulated a list rules to ensure our members safety in attending the “Fall Frenzy”. These rules were formulated directly from Public Health guidelines as well as current Ontario laws.

Attendees: We will NOT be allowed to have spectators in attendance. Minors (18 & under) are allowed to have a guardian with them. If you are needing someone to attend with you for driving purposes, child care, minor, parent etc. they MUST be approved by Denise Stoddart in advance, and will be asked to work helping to monitor adherence of COVID-19 rules. All guests must be approved by Denise by October 1 @ 12pm. Our shifts will be 1-2 hours per day, and we ask members to volunteer as well.

There will be a list of competitors as well as guardians/assistive individuals at the gate. If the individual has not been approved to attend, they will not be allowed admittance onto the property. We will supply wristbands which are expected to be worn for the whole weekend. Temperatures will be checked upon arrival.

Group sizing: There will be a maximum of 50 people in the arena at one time. Therefore, only 10 individuals will be allowed on horseback inside the arena. These riders will be in the competing drag, and drag following. Spectators (including competitors) will be allowed to watch friends or family members, but are asked to be mindful that others may be waiting to enter the building. There will be no large group congregating allowed. You must stick to your “bubble” (10 people maximum), and group sizing will be monitored.

We are going to be live-streaming the weekend. This will reduce the number of people indoors.

Masks: Masks must be worn at all times when in event venues. You may only remove your mask to compete. These buildings include arenas (indoor and outdoor) as well as barns. You are not required to wear a mask at your own trailer/campsite.

Parking: This will be assigned. Upon arrival, you will check-in at the gate. You will then be given your designated parking area. Camping and haul-ins will be in separate areas.

Sanitization: We will have sanitizing stations and signage at each entrance to the barn buildings, arena, and at the office. You MUST sanitize each time you pass one of these stations.

People on foot will only be allowed in the holding pens to assist horses that have difficulty getting in the pen. No other pedestrians will be permitted in this area.

Only individuals with stalled horses, or representatives on the riders behalf, will be permitted in the stalling areas.

Each of these rules will be strictly enforced and monitored. If you, or anyone in your group are found not in compliance, you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately. No refunds will be given in this case.
